1.a	Periodic checks of construction machinery to ensure compliance of emission standards	All the machinery used were standard
1.b	Water Sprinkling on unpaved road	Water sprinkling was carried out by water tankers on the unpaved road to mitigate the dust emission
1.c	Greenbelt will be developed at the facility	Sufficient amount of trees have been grown at the facility
1.d	Attenuation of pollution/protection of receptor through green belt/green cover	Sufficient amount of trees have been grown at the facility
